Junior Masters Tournament Rules

The Junior Masters is one of the most prestigious Scratch Youth Tournaments in the United States. It was started in 1981 and since that time, over \$300,000 in college scholarships have been awarded. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) (Certification #) and all applicable USBC rules will apply.

There will be separate divisions for male and female. Field is open to 288 total participants. Staff reserves the right to alter number of entries. This is a Scratch, singles tournament. No handicap will be used.

Eligibility – Participants in the Junior Masters Tournament must meet all of the following eligibility requirements:

Open to all USBC Youth members, card MUST be shown at check-in.

Age requirement: Bowlers must be 20 years of age, or younger as of August 1st, 2016.

Entry Fee - \$ 90.00 = \$35.00 Bowling fee, \$8.00 Tournament expense, \$47.00 Awards fee. 100% of all awards fees will be paid to the winners.

Entry Deadline - May 1st, 2017. Entries received after this date will be accepted, if slots are still available up to thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time. There is an additional late fee of \$15.00. Total Tournament entry fee for walk-ins and late entries = \$105.00.

USBC Junior Gold Qualifier - \$40 Entry Fee. Open to all Junior Gold members (\$30 for new membership). One (1) male and one (1) female will advance to the Junior Gold Championship depending on entries. Could be 2 males if not enough females enter.

Scholarships - Capri Lanes, Morehead State University and the awards fee will make up approximately \$25,000 in Scholarships. 100% of all awards will be returned to the scholarship fund through the SMART Program (Scholarship Management and Accounting Reports for Tenpins).

Qualifying Format – Athletes will qualify in the first six (6) game qualifying squad on Saturday, May 13th beginning at 8:45 am or 1:30 pm EST.

No re-entry: Bowlers may attempt to qualify in Block A OR Block B.

The lanes will be re-conditioned between Squad A, Squad B and the second round qualifier.

Two-thirds of all divisions (Squad A & B combined), will advance to the second round of six (6) qualifying games. The number of advancing boys and girls will not be released until total entries of each division are determined. This block will begin immediately following lane reconditioning Saturday evening. (Usually in the 6:30 – 7:00PM timeframe.) Bowlers advancing to the second qualifying round must be checked in prior to the start of practice. All advancers not checked in at this time will release their spot to the alternates in order of first round qualifying finish.

Saturday, May 13th Qualifying

Saturday, May 13th at 8:45 am and 1:30 pm athletes will bowl a 6 game qualifying block.

Based on entries in the 15 and under divisions bowlers may bowl all 12 games before the cut is made

Saturday, May 13th 8:45AM EST: Squad A will bowl a six (6) game qualifying block (practice will start at 8:45 am)

Saturday, May 13th 1:30PM EST: Squad B will bowl a six (6) game qualifying block (practice will start at 1:30 pm)

Saturday, May 13th approx. 6:00PM EST: First cut will be made – Scores are dropped

Saturday, May 13th immediately following reconditioning: Second round, six (6) game qualifying block

Saturday, May 13th immediately following second qualifying block: final cut to Sunday finals will be announced. Final cut will be to the top sixteen (16) boys and eight (8) girls in the 16 and older division and the 15 and under will be based on entries but a minimum of 4 of each the girls and boys division will advance to Sunday. Ties inside the cut will be determined by high game of the last block.

Sunday, May 14th Match Play Finals 7:45AM EST: Check in for Match Play Finals and ball check

Each match will be single elimination of two (2) games, total pinfall. Ties will be determined by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.

The higher seed will have the privilege of deciding who will start the match. The starting player will bowl one frame on the left lane. The remainder of the match will consist of each finalist bowling two (2) frames, at a time, until the game is finished.

All finalists will be allowed ten (10) minutes of practice on their beginning pair. Upon advancement, finalists will receive two (2) practice deliveries, per lane, on each new pair.

Final places for all bowlers losing in the same round will be determined based on seed position from the Saturday evening qualifying block.

Check in for the Sunday Match Play Finals is 7:45AM EST for ball check with tournament play to begin at **9:00AM EST.**

Pairings for the initial round of match play will be seeded by position based on second round total pin fall. (1 VS. 16, 2 VS. 15 etc).

College scholarships will be awarded to all finalists. Amount of scholarships will vary depending upon entries and will be awarded through the SMART Program (Scholarship Management and Accounting Reports for Tenpins).

Dress Code – Participants in the Junior Masters must be professional in appearance and meet the following dress code rules:

Shirts – Athletes must wear shirts that have a collar similar to golf, polo shirts or mock collar. T-shirt necklines are not allowed.

Female Apparel – Female athletes are required to wear trousers, skirts, culottes, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, culottes, skorts or walking shorts must be no shorter than one half the distance from the inseam to the top of the knee in length, and/or no shorter than the finger tips when arms are at their sides, while standing.

Male Apparel – Male athletes are required to wear trousers. Trousers must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms (ankles). No denim, warm up suits, hats of any kind or shorts.

Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling or inappropriate language/ gestures during tournament competition will not be allowed and may result in disqualification from the tournament.

No I-Pods, hats or any other non-medical head gear are permitted during competition. Cell phones must be turned off during competition.

You are bowling in a very prestigious tournament. Dress to impress! College recruiters and the world of bowling are watching!

Tournament Director has the final decision on any rule not covered.

All other USBC Rules apply.

Strike Challenge Rules – Friday, May 12th Separate Boys and Girls Division

One (1) ball per participant per round, only strikes advance.

Following rounds repeat until only one (1) participant in each division remains.

Lanes will be assigned randomly.

Must check in at the front desk between 7:45 pm– 8:15 pm
